NAFC RULES

1. In case of all solo & team Competitions in all grades, the age of a competitor on Jan. 1 of the year in which the competitions held will determine the right of entry. For the purposes of this Rule, a competitor whose birthday is 1 Jan is deemed to be under the age attained on that date.

2. Competitions are open to amateurs. Teachers or other professionals cannot compete in the category in which they major. All competitors must be pupils of a TCRG or ADCRG currently registered with An Coimision Le Rinci Gaelacha Dublin, Ireland, IDTANA & with your region.

3. A competitor may be disqualified for any of the following reasons:

a.) Conduct unbecoming a lady or gentleman b.) Failure to report on time to compete c.) Falsification of age or other important facts, i.e. teaching, award winning, competing under another competitor's name or number, etc. Penalty for a & c: Competitor will be disqualified from the Feis at which the occurrence happened and from all NAFC-registered Feisanna for a period of one year beginning at the date of the occurrence.

4. Competition will be closed if there are no competitors at the assigned stage ready to compete when the competition is scheduled or announced.

5. Solo competitors in beginner, novice or open (prizewinner) competition a.) Must compete in their own age group b.) Must be prepared to perform two steps in each in each event c.) Cannot change competitions on the day of the Feis d.) Dance two competitors at a time

6. Figure Dancing: Teachers/Team Captains are responsible that their teams are complete and in position when the competition is announced. Competitors may compete in the next higher age group, however, a competitor may compete in only one.

7. Steel taps or "bubble" heels on dancing shoes, display of awards, wearing of shorts or other unconventional dress is prohibited. Authentic Gaelic dress is desired.

8. Competitors' numbers must be worn and visible to adjudicators when performing in all competitions

9. Awards will be determined in proportion to the number of competitors entered in each competition and to the degree of proficiency shown.

10. Musicians and adjudicators cannot be approached during a competition by anyone except the Feis Committee. No one can approach them while a competitor is performing. Good sportsmanship, as well as ladylike and gentlemanly conduct by all is desired throughout the Feis.

11. Complaints must be in writing, stating names and other factual information, and signed by the complainant. A \$10.00 fee must be enclosed and presented to the Feis Chairman within one hour of the occurrence. The fee will be returned if the complaint is upheld.

12. The Feis Committee and any organization affiliated with same will not be held responsible for personal injury, property loss or damage. Destruction of Feis property or rental property will be punishable by law.

13. The Feis reserves the right to reject any entry for cause, to cancel all or part of the Feis and to limit competitor's performing time. The decision of the Feis committee is final in all matters connected with the Feis.

14. Competitors must answer all questions as required by the Feis entry committee, including Teacher's name and enclosed entry fee when mailing or else the entry will be rejected. The official entry card must be used. Entries must be postmarked on or before the closing date or subject to a late fee.

15. Entrants in any Championship event may not enter in any other solo events, or traditional set but may enter in figure dances. Entrants in Open Championships should specify, on the entry form their choice of set dance. Und 9 dance Traditional Set. Entrants cannot change competition or category on the day of the Feis. a) Standard Age Groups for Open Championship, b.) Boys & girls must be advertised separately if less than 5 boys per competition Feis organizers will combine with 1 age group up. If this cannot be done and there is 1 boy then they will ask the boy if he would prefer to be combined with the girls competition of his age or dance alone. The status of a dancer does not change unless there are 5 or more dancers in a competition.

16. Preliminary championships are open to those who, at any NAFC sanctioned Feis: a.) Have placed 1st in soft shoe and hard shoe as a prizewinner, or b.) Have never placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in Open Championships

17. Championships require at least three adjudicators.

18. First place winners in open championship category cannot return to Preliminary or Open (PW)

19. The use of flash, video, digital or motions picture cameras prohibited during a dance competition except for press use or Feis Committee documentation.

20. As of Sept. 1, 2005 no block endpoint stationary or moving maybe performed by any ages up to and including under 12 age groups.

21. Make up is prohibited on a dancer in the first three grades (First Feis (if offered), Beginner and Advance Beginner or their equivalent) up to and including the under 12 age group.

22. Any competitor found to be using artificial carriage aids and subsequently refuses to remove same, will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition. Medically prescribed aids (proof of which may be required) will be exempt from this rule.

Feis is registered and sanctioned and will be governed by the rules of An Coimisiun, the North American Feis Commission, and the New England Region.
